2015 NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S LACROSSE CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTIONS

INDIANAPOLIS---The NCAA Division I Men's Lacrosse Committee announced the field for its championship tournament today.

The following conferences and their representatives received automatic qualification:

America East Conference	University at Albany
Atlantic Coast Conference	Syracuse University
Big East Conference	University of Denver
Colonial Athletic Association	Towson University
Big Ten Conference	Johns Hopkins University
The Ivy League	Yale University
Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference	Marist College
Northeast Conference	Bryant University
Patriot League	Colgate University
Southern Conference	High Point University

The top 14 teams have been placed in the bracket, while the remaining four teams will compete for the chance to advance to the round of 16. Those games will take place Wednesday, May 6 with High Point traveling to Towson and Bryant playing at Marist.

The remainder of the field was selected at large: Brown University, Cornell University, Duke University, University of Maryland, College Park, University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, University of Notre Dame, The Ohio State University, University of Virginia.

All Division I round of 16 games will be televised on ESPNU or ESPN2 May 9 and 10. The

quarterfinal games will also all be televised on ESPN2 or ESPNU May 16 and 17. The Division I semifinal and championship games, and the Division II and III championship games, will be held at Lincoln Financial Field in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, May 23-25 and hosted by Drexel University. The Division I semifinals will be televised live on ESPN2 starting at 1 p.m. Eastern time, May 23. The championship game will be televised live on ESPN2 starting at 1 p.m. Eastern time, May 25.
